About the Institute

North Eastern Institute of Ayurveda and Homoeopathy (NEIAH) is an Autonomous Institute, under the Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India located at Mawdiangdiang, Shillong, Meghalaya. The Institute has been established by the Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India with the aim to impart Graduate, Post-graduate, Doctoral and Research Programme in Ayurveda and Homoeopathy and also provide quality medical facilities and act as referral hospitals. At present, the Institute is running one College of Ayurveda & one College of Homoeopathy offering undergraduate courses in BAMS (Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine Surgery) and BHMS (Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine & Surgery).

Since the commencement of its academic program in 2016-17, the Institute has admitted more than 900 students to date. The first batch of students graduated in 2022, and currently 6th batch is pursuing their internship. The Institute has successfully organized National Seminars, Regional Seminar and CME's for Faculty & Medical officers, and several webinars. Prominent Scholars of Ayurveda, Homoeopathy, Yoga, and Research field are timely invited for Guest Lectures for the benefit of students of the Institute. The Institute commenced Postgraduate (PG) courses in Homoeopathy in 04 subjects, with 02 seats in each subject, from the academic session 2023–24, and Postgraduate (PG) courses in Ayurveda in 08 subjects, with 02 seats in each subject, from the academic session 2025–26.

The Institute is going to admit **63** candidates each for BAMS (Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine Surgery) and BHMS (Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine & Surgery) courses for the academic session 2026-27. Out of 63 seats, 31 seats will be for All India Quota, 31 seats will be for North East States Quota and one seat is for Foreign National.

All India Quota:

A total of **31 seats in each course** under the All India Quota shall be filled directly by the **Ministry of Ayush through centralized counseling**, as per the schedule and procedure notified on the official website of the **Ayush Admissions Central Counseling Committee (AACCC)** at www.aaccc.gov.in. The **Foreign National seat** shall be filled through the **Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR)** as per the applicable rules and guidelines.

North East States Quota:

A total of **31 seats in each course** under the North East States Quota shall be filled through **counseling conducted by the respective State/UT Counseling Authorities**. Candidates who have qualified in **NEET (UG) 2026**, conducted by the **National Testing Agency (NTA)**, and are desirous of seeking admission to NEIAH under the **North East States Quota (except Assam)** for the above-mentioned courses are advised to contact their respective **State/UT Counseling Authority** for the counseling schedule, registration, seat allotment and other admission-related procedures.

Note:

1. Institute reserves the right to make any amendment or cancellation of this advertisement wholly or partially without assigning any reason thereof.
2. **All provisionally selected/allotted candidates have to submit allotment letter issued by the State/ UT counseling authority alongwith other relevant Original documents at the time of admission.**
3. The admission to the said courses will be subject to the production of a physical and medical fitness certificate issued by a Competent Medical Board, constituted by the Institute.
4. The provisionally selected /allotted candidate shall have to appear for counseling of via their respective state counseling authority.
5. The date for determining the age limit is **31st December 2026.**
6. **During admission, a student with his/her parents/ guardians has to furnish a Bond on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 10/- for the payment of liquidated charges at Rs. 50,000/- or Rs.3,00,000/-, whichever is applicable, for non-completion of the course. (Annexure- III & Annexure- IV).**
7. **During admission, a student with his/her parents/ guardians has to furnish a Bond on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 10/- for Anti Ragging Bond. (Annexure- V & Annexure- VI).**
8. **A student has also to submit all original certificates at the time of admission, which shall be duly returned on completion of the course.**
9. 75% attendance as per NEHU / respective Council rules is mandatory for the students to be eligible for appearing in the annual examination.
10. **Any corrigendum/ order regarding this advertisement will be issued and posted on the Institute's website (www.neiah.nic.in) only.** Candidates are advised to remain in touch with the website for this purpose. No separate corrigendum etc. will be published in newspapers.
11. **No TA/ DA** will be entitled to the candidates for appearing in counseling/ admission.
12. **In respect, if any matter related to admission procedure for the session 2026-27, the decision of the Director NEIAH will be final.**

Courses & Distribution of Seats:

The Institute conducts the 5½ years (including one year internship) Degree Course in Ayurveda and Homoeopathy viz., Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery (B.A.M.S.) & Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery (B.H.M.S.) respectively. The courses are full-time regular courses as per the regulation of respective Councils, approved by Govt. of India and Govt. of Meghalaya. Both the courses are affiliated with the North-Eastern Hill University (NEHU), Shillong.

***31 (Thirty-one) seats under the All India Open Seats will be filled up based on NEET 2026 Merit. Admission for the same will be done by AYUSH via central counseling www.aaccc.gov.in .**

**** In respect of Meghalaya State 9 (nine) nos. of seats both BAMS and BHMS will henceforth remain constant for all academic sessions. In respect of other North-Eastern states (Except Assam), 4 (four) nos. of seats in BAMS & BHMS will be allocated to 04 (four) states and 03 (three) nos. of seats will be allotted to 2 (two) states for the present academic session. The number of seats will change amongst the North-Eastern states as per Institute roaster.**

Eligibility Criteria: As per NEET-2026 guidelines and respective council's rules.

Medical Examination:

The selected candidates shall have to undergo a medical examination by a Medical Board set up by the Institute, consisting of consultants of the Institute. If in the assessment of the Medical Board, a candidate is found medically unfit to be admitted to the course, he/she will be rejected and will not be admitted and the decision of the Board shall be final in this regard. In that case, in his/her place, the next student in the order of merit will be admitted.

Date of Joining:

Admitted candidates must join classes by the date stipulated by the Institute for the year of admission. The admission of the candidate, who fails to join the classes by the stipulated date, shall automatically stand cancelled and such seats shall then be offered to the candidates on the waiting list in order of merit.

Fees & Expenses:

All the selected candidates are required to pay the admission fee, course fees, and other deposits, etc. as per the rule in force only by **Challan/Online**.
